The author provides an extensive set of slides used as the basis for a CES workshop on working with results-based management framework (RMAF) and Ongoing Performance Management Systems (OPMS). Based on experience developed within the National Crime Prevention Centre, the presentation is extremely well organized and promises to help the uninitiated reader to familiarize with the many terms and concepts associated with RMAF and OPMS and to develop an awareness of challenges, benefits and practical issues in development and use. Some practical examples are included.

The abbreviated paper extrapolates from experiences within the education sector and discusses how portfolio assessments have been and can be used for different functions in program evaluation. Three models of using portfolio assessment for program evaluation are presented: (1) the aggregated model, where data are created at the individual level and aggregated to the program level; (2) the semi-aggregated model where data are created at a lower group level (school, program site) and subsequently aggregated to the program level for analysis and (3) the non-aggregated model, where program portfolios are created at the

program level. The paper discusses interesting advantages and issues in implementing portfolio-based program evaluation and lays out an agenda for research.

This time it was not easy to select. I have chosen Gerald Halpern's "View from the Outside", a response to Doug Mac Donald's paper "Internal Audit in the Canadian Federal Government". Both articles are well worth reading. I am presenting Gerald Halpern's paper partially for the dialogue it encourages about the direction evaluation might or could take. Gerald Halpern's response to the above article and the "Life Cycle Approach to Managing for Results" presented by the Centre of Excellence for Evaluation gives a brief evaluation history and outlines current issues. He responds specifically to the relationship he believes, should exist between evaluation and internal audit. I chose the article for its innovative, challenging perspective. It is very likely to produce dialogue among evaluators who's orientation centers around organizational learning and participatory approaches to outcomes and those who advocate for professional independence as distinct from these.

Much of our work in evaluation suffers from weak attribution and, according to Contandriopoulos, also lacks a clear target audience when it refers to the public.

Spending much of my time dealing with the various aspects of accountability, indicators, performance measurement and the plethora of related terms, I always find John Mayne's presentations to be both informative and thought provoking. In this presentation John talks about the modern pressures for accountability that we are all being faced with, its purposes, and how accountability means many things to many people. The principles for effective accountability are ones which are often hard to obtain, whether we work in the public or not-for-profit sector. Roles and responsibilities and performance expectations are never as clear as we would like them to be, and organizations are often not effective at balancing expectations with capabilities. While the accountability framework presented in this presentation is intuitive, its components do not always occur in practice. If you have an interest in this area, I encourage you to read the OAG references cited; as they will prove to be an excellent addition to your accountability literature. Hopefully, before I retire, we will find the clarity we are all seeking!
